The artist may submit two pieces in any of the four categories: oil/acrylic, photography/printmaking, watermedia, and pastel. **Work must not have been exhibited in the CAC galleries previously.** All work must be for sale. CAC receives a 30% commission on all sales. Work that is copied or done under the guidance of an instructor is not eligible. **Painting may not exceed 40" in any direction including frame.** All work must be framed, wired and suitable for hanging.

LIABILITY:

The Creative Arts Center will exercise due care in handling the art work but is not responsible for any damage that may occur during moving or hanging. All works will be insured against fire, theft, and vandalism during the exhibition.
