MATERIALS LIST**

PIGMENTS Watercolors OR Acrylic paints– blues, reds, yellows, earth colors
If you don't have paints, you can work with colored pencils, pastels or just torn
and/or cut papers

BRUSHES

Flat ½ inch or larger; Round, No. 6 or larger for painting with WC or acrylic
Inexpensive brush for glues – about ½ inch or larger – can purchase at a paint
store

PALETTES

Watercolor palette or plastic dishes

GLUES

ELMER'S GLUE or Acrylic Matte or Acrylic Gloss Medium

PAPER

140lb or 300 lb WC Paper
Old watercolor paintings to tear up if you like
(I will have some oriental papers and colored papers available for purchase)
Bring "Found" papers (old letters, magazine clips, or other interesting pieces)

OTHER "STUFF"

Board (Styrofoam, Gatorboard or heavy cardboard
to work on) **THIS IS A MUST**
Containers for water-- plastic tub-like containers from store (Cool Whip a good
one) Bring at least 2 containers, you'll need a separate one for glue.
Paper Towels
Tissues
Scissors
Sketchbook, pencils, notebook
Old toothbrush (for splattering)
