#### **Brushes:**

A selection of bristle and/or natural hair brushes, sizes ranging from small to large. Some synthetic brushes work well. Nylon brushes are not recommended. Suggested brush profiles can be filberts, flats, brights and rounds. Badger Hair brushes, (Langnickel, Rosemary or Isabel brands work well) for working on edges

Painting Medium: Painting Medium (I use Liquin)

Brush Cleaner: Mineral Spirits, turpentine, paint thinner or other brush cleaner.

**Canvas:** Panels using linen, cotton duck, or polyflex. Sizes: Smaller sizes strongly recommended. Not to exceed 14 x 18.
