

## Painting 101/102 Supply List - 2021

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I am delighted that you are joining our class. To help you with purchasing supplies, I am listing my suggestions, but do bring any supplies you already have. The easiest and most economical route is to purchase everything on line at Blick Art : <http://www.dickblick.com> They are very reasonably priced and ship quickly. Be sure to use the discount code for free shipping at \$45 - found in their header. And I always opt for the additional \$3 Fed Ex. fast shipping. If you purchase ALL of the items at Blick Art, it will cost about \$135, plus whichever canvases you choose. If you already have some supplies, certainly bring them!

I highly recommend water based oils as they don't require any solvents, and clean up with soap and water. However, if you already have traditional oils or acrylics, please feel free to use them. Basically you will need:

Paint, Brushes, Brush cleaner, 1tube acrylic for toning, disposable paper palette.

**PAINTS:** can be ordered from Blick or purchased locally. Paints are far less expensive if ordered. There are two brands I recommend : Windsor Newton Artisan, and Holbein DUO. Windsor Newton is very affordable and for most colors that's what I use. Holbein DUO's consistency is a little more buttery, and I do like that, so I'll splurge on it now and then. Some of the more unusual colors like Lavender or Leaf Green are only found in Holbein Duo. And do buy the small tubes - 35-50 ml. They last a long time.

You will also need one tube of ACRYLIC- Raw Sienna or Yellow Ochre - any inexpensive brand. Used for toning your canvas.

Blick Studio Acrylic - Yellow Oxide – Item#: [01637-4110](#)

Oil colors that are nice to have but not at all necessary to start: (\* you will love the starred colors! )

Burnt Umber, Dioxinine Purple, Yellow Ochre, Phthalo Green ( blue shade )

In Holbein DUO only: \* Lavender, \*Leaf Green, \*Lilac, \*Turquoise Blue

## **BRUSHES**

With brushes, quality is VERY important. Poorly made brushes will frustrate you fast! You will need a selection of long handled FLATS , BRIGHTS and ROUNDS. I recommend synthetic oil/acrylic brushes, rather than natural bristle. I will list suggestions, but please bring what you already have too.

These are the brushes I use myself. You should have an assortment of types and sizes. (my favorite is the size 12 Bright)

A very nice starter set about \$20. ( includes size 12 bright )

## **BRUSH CLEANER**

And to protect your brushes, this is the best/ easiest brush cleaner - highly recommend!

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## **CANVAS**

I use Blick Premier stretched cotton canvases. The traditional 3/4" width is fine.

Sometimes I opt for the 1.5" Gallery width, for the unframed look.

I like the splines back rather than stapled, but it doesn't really matter. You can buy canvases locally too. You could use canvas boards if you prefer, in the smaller sizes. Larger canvas boards tend to warp, so be aware of that.

So choose some stretched canvases in whatever sizes you would like to work with. Feel free to go *large!*

## **PALETTE**

Finally – you will need a disposable paper palette. This is like a pad of waxy paper. I like the 9x 12 size
